### MINUTES

A. CALL TO ORDER

Hearing Officer Ablao called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

C. ACTION ITEMS

1. **NEW – Special Event Permit**

Hearing Officer Ablao opened the public meeting for NEW Special Event Permit for Windsor Chamber of Commerce. Hearing Officer Ablao swore in Michelle Vance, Executive Director Windsor Chamber of Commerce, and Mandy Mullen, owner run.Windsor.

Ms. Vance reported the Windsor Chamber of Commerce has a partnership with run.Windsor, and sponsors the Windsor 5K Race. The Windsor Chamber staff organizes and manages all the rest stops for the race, and partners with Mandy Mullen. The participants of the race will all receive a runner's bib, which can be exchanged for one free beverage in the designated area after showing valid ID and receiving a wrist band. Ms. Vance reported 450 participants will attend the 5K race providing exposure for the Windsor Chamber of Commerce, and the Town of Windsor.

Hearing Officer Ablao opened the meeting for public comment to which there was none.

The Authority finds that the evidence presented at the hearing today supports the approval of the NEW Special Event License for Windsor Chamber of Commerce, and therefore approves the granting of the license with the following conditions: Compliance with the state liquor code, rules, regulations and all municipal ordinances and regulations concerning the operation of a liquor licensed business.

2. **TRANSFER – Beer & Wine (CITY)**

Hearing Office Ablao opened the public meeting for TRANSFER Beer & Wine License for HighFive, LLC DBA HighFive. Hearing Officer Ablao swore in Emily Diener, owner HighFive, LLC with legal representative Trent Cromartie.

Mr. Cromartie reported on the Transfer, Integrity Sports Arena, to HighFive, LLC. Integrity Sports Arena is an athletic complex that hosts sports, and training events for athletes. HighFive is located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of Integrity Sports Arena, and has been in operation since December 2021, serving as a snack bar refreshment area for patrons. The hours of operation are Monday-Friday 5:00pm-12:00am, and Saturday-Sunday 8:00am – 12:00am. Everyone that enters the establishment will have I.D.'s checked under 50 years old, and a violation of any State or local liquor code rules or regulations could result in legal criminal and administrative penalties. HighFive has a total of (3) employees, and all are TIPS certified. Drinks are distributed (1) drink per ID, and no more than (2) alcoholic beverages are served to patron within an hour. A full menu will be available during business hours.

Hearing Officer Ablao opened the meeting for public comment to which there was none.


